પાકું લાયસન્સ મેળવવા માટેની પદ્ધતિ

- A. પાકું લાયસન્સ મેળવવાની લાયકાત :**
(i) અરજદાર જે તે કેટગરીના વાહન નાદે યોગ્ય લાગિંગ લાયસન્સ મેળવેલ હોવું જોઈએ.
(ii) લાગિંગ લાયસન્સ મળ્યાના ૧ મહિના બાદ જ અરજદાર પાકા લાયસન્સ માટે ટેસ્ટ આપી શકશે.
- B. પાકું લાયસન્સ મેળવવા અરજદારે કરવાની થતી કાર્યવાહી :**
(i) અરજદારે ડ્રાઈવિંગ ટેસ્ટ માટે તારીખ અને સમય મેળવવા ઓનલાઈન બુકિંગ www.parivahan.gov.in વેબસાઈટ પર કરવાનું રહેશે. (ii) ઓનલાઈન એપોઈન્ટમેન્ટની સ્વીકૃતિ સાથે અરજદાર જે તે તારીખ અને સમયે આર.ટી.ઓ. કચેરીમાં ડ્રાઈવિંગ ટેસ્ટ ટ્રેકના રજીસ્ટ્રેશન કાઉન્ટર પર હાજર થવાનું રહેશે. (iii) અરજદારે લાગિંગ લાયસન્સ (ઓરીજિનલ) અને પાકા લાયસન્સ માટેની ફી ભર્યાનું ચલણ સાથે રાખવું જરૂરી છે. (iv) અરજદાર જે પ્રકારના લાયસન્સ માટે અરજી કરેલ છે તેવા પ્રકારના વાહન સાથે ડ્રાઈવિંગ ટેસ્ટ આપવાનો થાય છે, જેથી આવા પ્રકારનું વાહન સાથે લાવવાનું રહેશે.
- C. રજીસ્ટ્રેશન ડેસ્ક પર પહોંચ્યા પછીની કામગીરી નીચે મુજબ રહેશે. :**
(i) રજીસ્ટ્રેશન ડેસ્ક પર અરજદારે લાગિંગ લાયસન્સ અને પાકા લાયસન્સ માટે ફી ભર્યાનું ચલણ ચકાસાણી માટે આપવાના રહેશે. (ii) કોન્સુમેન્ટ ચકાસ્યા બાદ અરજદારનું બાયોમેટ્રિક વેરિફિકેશન કરવામાં આવશે. (iii) અરજદારનું રજીસ્ટ્રેશન ડ્રાઈવિંગ ટેસ્ટ ટ્રેક સિસ્ટમમાં કરવામાં આવશે અને અરજદારને ટોકન નંબર આપવામાં આવશે. ટોકન નંબર સાથે અરજદારને ટેસ્ટ આપવાનો રહેશે.
- D. (i) જો અરજદારે ફોર વ્હીલર માટે અરજી કરી હોય તો તેને નીચે જણાવેલ ચાર ટેસ્ટ આપવાના રહેશે. (ii) સીધા ચઢાણનો (અપગ્રેડીયન્ટ) ટેસ્ટ (iii) અંત્રેણ ૮ ટેસ્ટ (iii) રીવર્સ "S" ટેસ્ટ (iv) પેરેલલ પાર્કિંગ ટેસ્ટ (ii) જો અરજદાર ટુ વ્હીલર માટે અરજી કરી હોય તો તેને સર્પેન્ટાઈન (અંત્રેણ ૮) ટેસ્ટ આપવાનો રહેશે.**
- E. ટ્રેક પર ટેસ્ટ આપ્યા બાદ પાકું લાયસન્સ કઈ રીતે મળશે ?**
(i) અરજદારે પોતાના ટેસ્ટનું પરિણામ રજીસ્ટ્રેશન ડેસ્ક પરથી લેવાનું રહેશે. (ii) જો અરજદાર ટેસ્ટમાં પાસ થશે તો પાકું લાયસન્સ નક્કી સમયમર્યાદામાં પોસ્ટ મારફતે મળી જશે. (iii) જો અરજદાર ટેસ્ટમાં નાપાસ હશે તો તેને પોતાના કોન્સુમેન્ટ પોતાની સાથે જ રાખવાના રહેશે અને એક અઠવાડિયા પછી ફરીથી ટેસ્ટ આપવા માટે આવી શકશે. (iv) અરજદાર રિટેસ્ટ આપવા માટે પહેલા આર.ટી.ઓ. કચેરીમાં રિટેસ્ટની ફી ભરવાની રહેશે અને ફી ભર્યાના ચલણ સાથે રજીસ્ટ્રેશન ડેસ્ક પર હાજર રહેવાનું રહેશે.

(૧) ફોર વ્હીલર સીધા ચઢાણનો (અપગ્રેડીયન્ટ) ટેસ્ટ

- (૧) આ ટેસ્ટમાં દાખલ થવા માટે પ્રથમ ગ્રીન લાઈટ જોવી. જો અન્ય કોઈ ગાડી ટ્રેકમાં હોય તો તેમાં દાખલ થવું નહીં. (૨) આ ટેસ્ટના સીધા ચઢાણ પર વાહન ચલાવવાનું રહેશે. વાહનને ચિત્રમાં દર્શાવ્યા પ્રમાણે નક્કી કરેલ સ્થાને STOP લાઈન પર ઉભું રાખી વાહનનું એન્જિન બંધ કરી હેન્ડબ્રેક ખેંચવાની રહેશે.

(૨) ફોર વ્હીલર ૮ ટેસ્ટ / Forward "8" Test

- (૧) આ ટેસ્ટમાં દાખલ થવા માટે પ્રથમ ગ્રીન લાઈટ જોવી. જો અન્ય કોઈ વાહન ટ્રેકમાં હોય તો તેમાં દાખલ થવું નહીં. (૨) ટેસ્ટ માટેનો મહત્તમ સમય ૨ મિનિટનો રહેશે. (૩) આ ટેસ્ટમાં દાખલ થતાં જ કોમ્પ્યુટર સમયની નોંધ કરશે અને ૯૦ સેકન્ડની અંદર આ ટેસ્ટ પૂરો કરવાનો રહેશે. (૪) ટ્રેકની ઉપર બતાવેલ એરોની દિશા પ્રમાણે આપનું વાહન ચલાવવાનું રહેશે. (૫) ટ્રેકમાં દર્શાવેલ માર્ગદર્શન નિશાન પ્રમાણે વાહન સેન્સર લગાવેલ પોલ (સ્તંભ) ને ન અથડાય તે રીતે ચલાવવું.

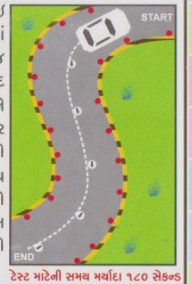

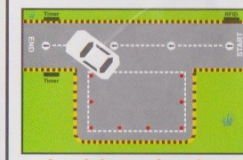

(૧) આ ટેસ્ટમાં દાખલ થવા માટે પ્રથમ ગ્રીન લાઇટ જોવી. જો અન્ય કોઈ વાહન ટ્રેકમાં હોય તો તેમાં દાખલ થવું નહીં. (૨) વાહનને આકૃતિમાં દર્શાવ્યા પ્રમાણે સીધી ટ્રેકમાં તેના ઉકા સુધી દાખલ થશે. દાખલ થતાં જ કોમ્પ્યુટર ટાઈમર દ્વારા ટેસ્ટ શરૂ થવાનો સમય નોંધાશે. (૩) ત્યાર બાદ રિવર્સમાં અંગ્રેજી "S" આકારે આકૃતિમાં બતાવ્યા પ્રમાણે વાહનને ચલાવવાનું રહેશે. (૪) ટેસ્ટ દરમિયાન ખાસ ધ્યાન આપો કે કોઈ સેન્સર લગાવેલ પોલને વાહન અથડાય નહીં. જો ૨ કરતા વધારે પોલને અથડાશે તો નાપાસ જાહેર કરવામાં આવશે. (૫) "S" આકારનો ટ્રેક જ્યાં પૂરો થાય છે ત્યાં ટાઈમરની વચ્ચે બરાબર વાહન ઉભું રાખો. અહીં આપના ટેસ્ટનો સમય પૂરો થયેલ નોંધાશે. જો સમય ૩ મિનિટ કરતાં વધારે હશે તો નાપાસ જાહેર કરવામાં આવશે. ત્યારબાદ વાહનને સીધું બહાર કાઢવું અને આપનો ટેસ્ટ પૂરો થશે.

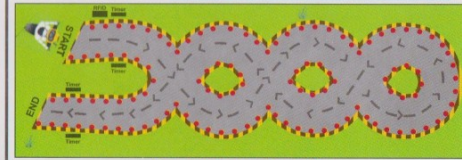

(૨) વાહનને આકૃતિમાં દર્શાવ્યા પ્રમાણે STOP લાઈન પર ઉભું રાખો. કોમ્પ્યુટર દ્વારા આપના ટેસ્ટ માટેનો સમય નોંધાશે. (૩) ટેસ્ટ દરમિયાન હેલ્મેટ પહેરવી ફરજીયાત છે. ટેસ્ટ દરમિયાન આપનો પગ ટ્રેક પર ન પડે તેની ખાસ તકેદારી રાખવી. જો ટ્રેક પર પગ પડશે તો નાપાસ જાહેર કરવામાં આવશે.
